


Please don't walk on our new floor!! With the installation of the new sprung floor and also the creation of a new one as you come into the gym near the kitchen area, it is a timely reminder that we ask visitors/ parents/siblings to not walk on the floor. Wearing shoes on the sprung floor can damage it, please walk around it. Thank you for your understanding.

Gymnasts /cheerleaders are not allowed to be on any equipment without a coach being present. They are not insured for activity on any equipment outside of class times.

If your child has a break/snack time in their class please send them with a light snack. Make sure they have a drink bottle even though the weather is cold and please ensure that they have warm clothes to put on after training.

Training attire needs to be a leotard or shorts and a fitted top. This enables coaches to see the gymnasts body form when doing skills. Also please don't forget gymnasts with long hair need it tied up for training. A bun is preferable as it keeps it well out of the way of the gymnasts face.

When parking in the car park please ensure that you only use what is allocated to us and don't block the access to the sale yard ramps. The


truck drivers have to try to manoeuvre the trucks around parked cars.
